**NOTE**

1. Gift Aid is tax relief on money donated to UK charities.
2. Donations are treated as if the donor had already deducted basic-rate tax from them. The charity can then reclaim this tax to increase the value of the donation.
3. Donors must pay enough UK income tax and / or capital gains tax themselves to cover the amount of tax the charity will reclaim.
4. Charities can only claim gift aid from personal donations, not companies
5. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Tax Return.
